

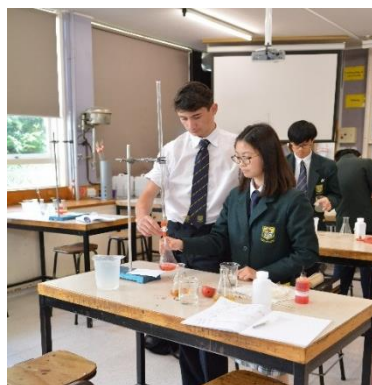
# ACADEMIC SUCCESS AT BAYFIELD HIGH SCHOOL



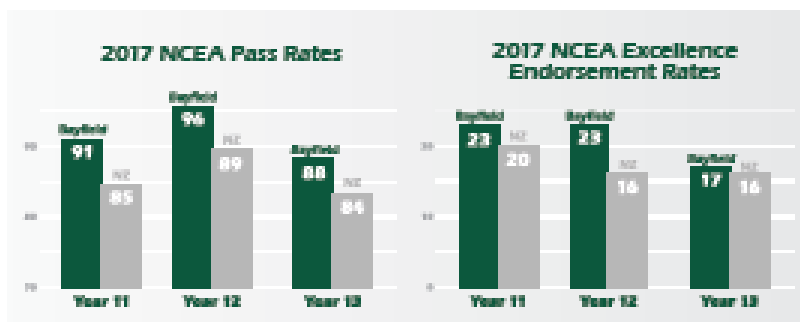
